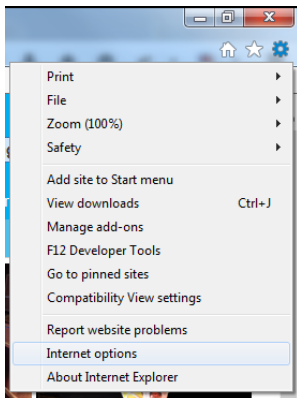

Internet Explorer

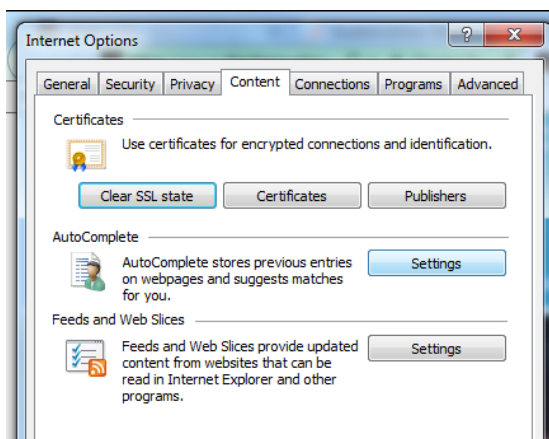
1. Open the '**Internet Explorer**' browser.
2. Go to the far right hand side of your window and Click on the 'Cog' symbol.



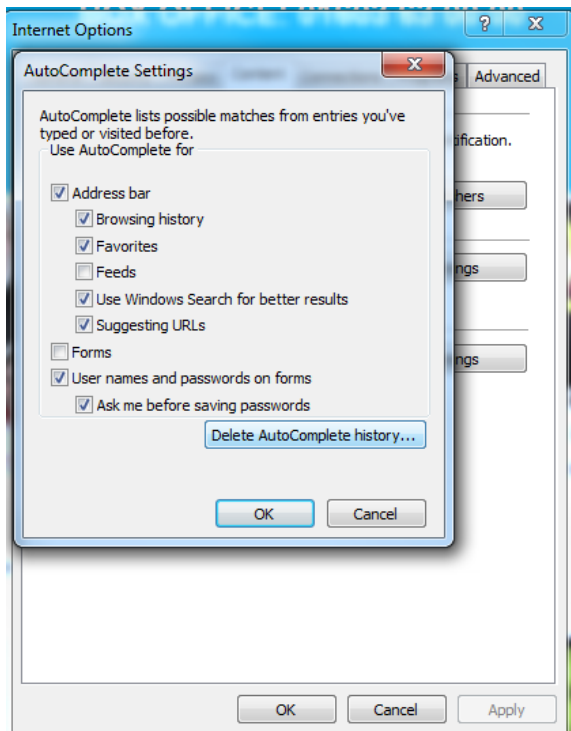
3. Scroll down the drop down menu. The Tools drop down menu will display a number of options scroll down to '**Internet Options**' and click.



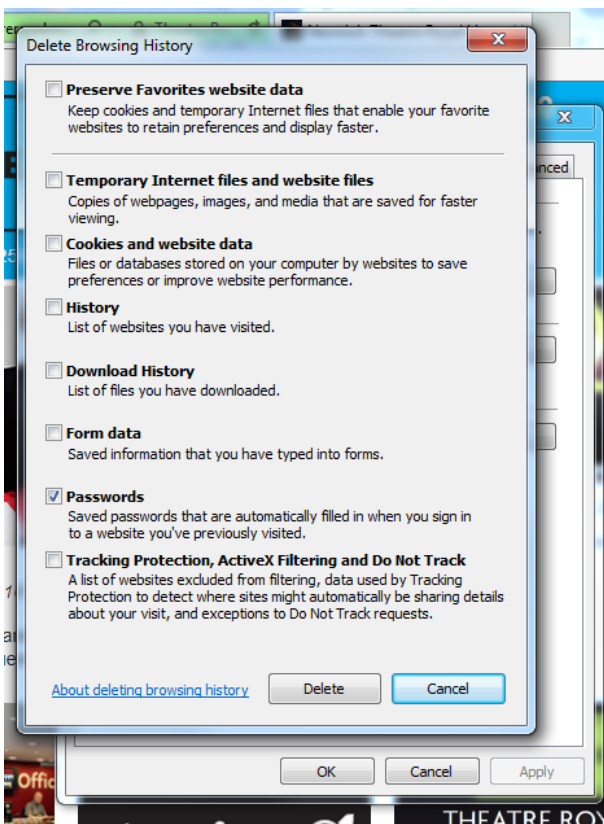
- Click on the '**Content**' tab of the Internet Options pop up window. Click on the '**Settings**' button underneath the **AutoComplete Area**.



- In the **AutoComplete Settings** pop up window, click on the '**Delete AutoComplete history**' button.



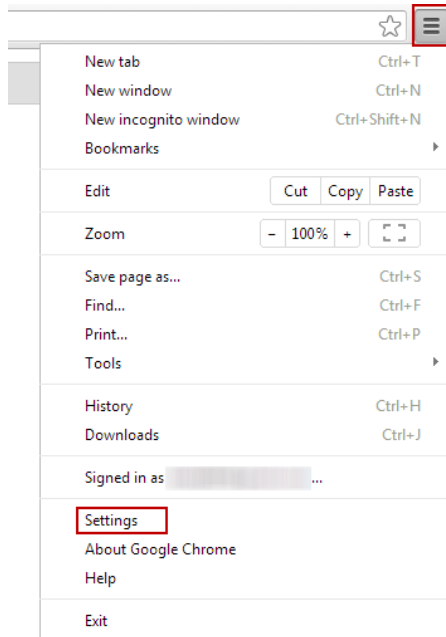
- Select the checkbox beside '**Password**'. Click on the '**Delete**' button and the stored password will be deleted.



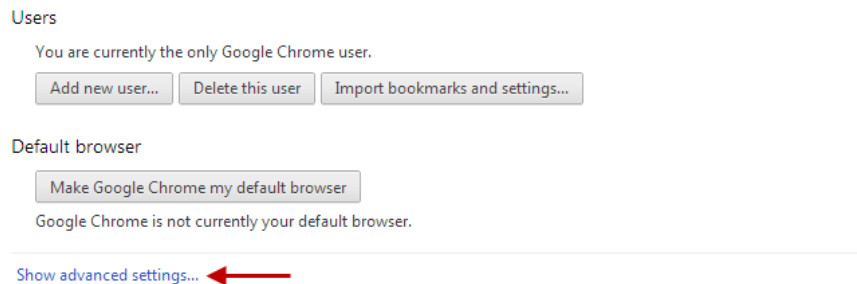

Google Chrome

1. Open the Google Chrome browser, then click on the **'Settings'** option.



2. Scroll down and click on the **'Show advanced settings'** link.

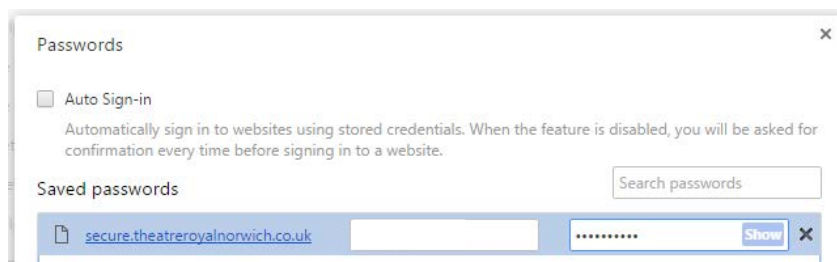


3. In the Passwords and forms section, click on the **'Manage saved passwords'** link.

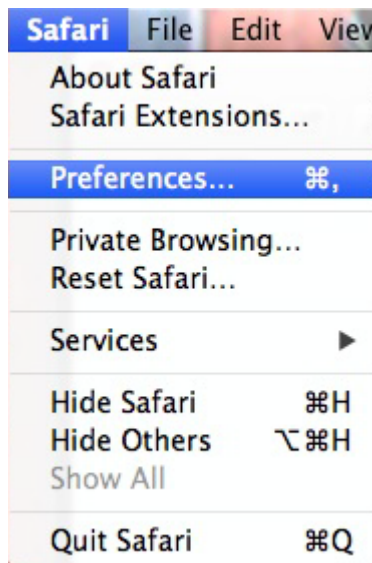

Safari

1. Launch '**Safari**' on your Mac.
2. In the top menu, Click on '**Safari**' and '**Preferences**'.



3. In the top navigation of the preferences menu, Click on '**Passwords**'.



4. A full list of all the passwords you currently have stored in Safari will appear. Just choose the one you'd like to delete. To select multiple items, just hold down **Command** on your keyboard. Click the '**Remove**' button.
